## **Hale Lawyer Breaks NSA Story**

### **Government Spying a Danger to the American People Regardless of their Innocence of any Wrongdoing, Hale case Proves**

Reverend Matt Hale is the former leader of the well-known and controversial World Church of the Creator, then the fastest growing white racist organization in America. He is the foremost religious prisoner of conscience in America, serving a 40 year sentence in federal prison for supposedly soliciting a government spy to murder Chicago district court Judge Joan Lefkow even though no evidence was produced at his trial that any such solicitation took place. The federal courts reviewing his case have thus far refused to release him in violation of the law, engaging in severe misconduct in a deliberate effort to cover up perhaps the most flagrant religious oppression by the federal government in America since the murder of the Branch Davidians at Waco in 1993. As Reverend Hale continues the fight for his vindication, he spoke out today regarding the NSA leak controversy, since similar spying by

the federal government was directly involved in the phony "case" against him with horrible consequences to him, his family, and his church. The NSA leak story, furthermore, was broke by Glen Greenwald, of The Guardian newspaper, who represented Reverend Hale in his fight for an Illinois law license and successfully represented him and his church when they were wrongly sued by victims of the Ben Smith racial shooting spree that occurred in Illinois and Indiana in July 1999.

From his prison cell at the infamous "Supermax" prison in Florence, Colorado, Rev. Hale had this to say:

"These past weeks since the NSA leak broke thanks to my lawyer Glenn Greenwald, I have read and heard many Americans in the press say that people should not be worried about government spying if they are innocent and have nothing to hide. I am here to tell them, from horrible personal experience that I suffer from every day, that they are terribly wrong. I knew that a government stooge, Tony Evola, was taping me for years but I didn't care since I knew that I would never commit a crime. Well, this scummy government of ours strung together years of recordings of me to successfully concoct a phony 'case' against me all the same. It took a letter here, and a letter there, and came into court with a completed phony 'alphabet' that hoodwinked the jury. So, don't think for a

minute that the innocence of the American people will protect them because if the government wants to railroad you, the NSA spy program will give it years of surveillance with which to do it. It will takes years of your NSA spied upon communications, glue them together, and fabricate a phony 'crime' out of them at will. The only solution is to end all federal spying on the American people and leave them the heck alone. Let my predicament be a warning of the dangers of such spying. I thought that my innocence would protect me. I was wrong."
