Motion to Allow Declarations by Non-Parties

It is Plaintiff's understanding that
some of his supporters, including his mother
Evelyn Hutcheson, have sought to file
declarations with the Court in support of
Plaintiff's recent Notice of Recent Continuing
Unlawful Activity by the Defendant and
its Employees Germane to the Eventual

Resolution of this Case (Doc. 204):

However, it is Plaintiff's understanding likewise that though the declarations have been duly mailed to the Clerk for filing, none have actually been filed as of yet, probably because they have been submitted by non-parties.

Plaintiff moves that these declarations be duly filed. They are highly relevant to the allegations made in Plaintiff's notice; specifically they corroborate and expand upon those allegations and thus should be accepted. Plaintiff would have "solicited" the declarations from his correspondents and mailed them in to the Court for filing himself if he could have but the problem with that, of course, is that the Defendant is stopping him from receiving mail from these various people in the first place. Plaintiff obviously can't attach declarations from his supporters to his own filings about his current mail situation when the Defendant won't

let him receive mail from them. Thus the declarations had to be sent to the Court by his supporters directly. Plaintiff has every right to have declarations filed on his behalf just as the Defendant has done for itself; the Defendant should not be rewarded for its unlawful censorship of Plaintiff's mail by virtue of Plaintiff's correspondents not being allowed to support his allegations with their own declarations.

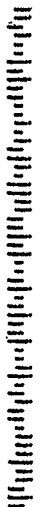
